

HOSPITAL PRICE RATES CLASSIC ADMISSION

• Nursing Day price

The nursing day price is indicated at the registration desks in the hospital

• Room supplement

The following supplements are due for your hospital room:

[Single room, no shower	36.04 EUR / day
[Single room with shower	42.50 EUR / day
[Single room + "rooming-in":	35.33 EUR to 41.67 EUR + 5.41 EUR/ day
["Rooming-in" with children :	5.41 EUR / day

A lump sum of 0.62 EUR/Day is charged for medicines. On top of this personal share, additional lump sums and acts (laboratory, physiotherapy,...) can be charged, depending on the treatment or medical act that you have undergone. The above-mentioned basic prices are subject to review, though only when based on a government decision.

• Physician's fee

- [For patients who are hospitalized in a common room the price rates of the official Belgian health insurance are applicable (personal share included, i.e. the 'convention price rate')
- [For patients who have opted to be treated by a physician who has not subscribed to the convention, and who are hospitalised in a common room or a double room, no supplement can be charged
- [For patients who have request to be hospitalized in a single room, a supplement can be charged which amounts to 150% of the above-mentioned price rate.

These supplements can be applied when legally allowed.

A compensation for room comfort is charged

- For hospitalization in a double room: 5.50 EUR/Day
- For hospitalization in a common room: 2.75 EUR/Day

The list of physicians who have (or have not) subscribed the convention (1) can be consulted at the patient registration desks in the hospital or on the website www.olvz.be. In absence of a valid convention, the price rates are set in consultation between the Medical Council and the departments.

Upon dismissal from the hospital, a full invoice will be issued. No payments are required during your stay in the hospital, except for services of hairdresser, pedicure and for purchase of newspapers, magazines, drinks and snacks from the vending machine, for which separate payment is required.
